

Schultz 2009 Summer Action League

- 1) The league will consist of 16 stages shot over 12 weeks. There will be 4 different course arrays. Each course array will be set up for three consecutive weeks and consist of 4 stages. In order to be eligible for prize money you must shoot at least 2 arrays of each of the four courses or have paid in advance for a full season (\$100.00 instead of \$10.00 per night). You can shoot both of the required arrays on the same night. You can shoot each of the courses as many times as you wish and pay for, time permitting, but only your best two will count towards placement for cash prizes. Once a course of fire has ended its three-week run it will not be available for shooting. If you do not shoot the required number of weeks you will still be eligible for the awards night dinner.
- 2) **Practice Night will be May 5th. Course (1) will be shot on May 12th, 19th, & June 2nd. Course 2 will be shot on June 9th, 16th, & 23rd. Course 3 will be shot on June 30th, July 7th, & 14th. Course 4 will be shot on July 21st, July 28th, and August 4th.** If we get rained out we will have one make up night on August 11th date. Start times will be 6:00, but you can show up and still shoot as long as you get to the first stage firing line prior to 7:15 pm.
- 3) The average course of fire will have approximately 70 to 80 rounds. Each course will have one steel stage, one long course and 2 short courses. Everyone will be expected to paste targets, set steel, and help RO/Score. The more participation we have the more enjoyable this will be for everyone.
- 4) You will need a holster, extra speed loaders or magazines (the largest course of fire could require 30 rounds), and eye and ear protection.
- 5) The cost will be \$10.00 per course or a one time fee of \$100.00. Awards night will be August 18th at the Schultz Gun Club Clubhouse at 6:30 pm. Food and beverages will be provided at no charge. Advanced sign up is required, so that we can plan the right amount of food. We will need to know who is attending by August 11th, 2006
- 6) There will be two divisions Open and Limited. The number of participants in each division will determine the cash payout. We may consider a third division if there are enough participants.
- 7) The clubhouse will be open for refreshments and snacks/pizzas after the match. There will be trap shooting available for those of you interested in shooting a round or two or three of trap.
- 8) All calibers of guns from 22 cal up thru 45 are allowed.
