### *Membership*

Membership is open to any citizen of the United States, 21 years of age or older, who is of suitable character.

Membership provides unlimited personal use of the grounds and facilities in accordance with rules and guidelines established by the board and membership. The grounds and facilities are intended for the use of members only. Membership is considered a family membership which includes spouse/significant other and children under the age of 21.

### **Responsibilities**

During the year, members are expected to contribute at least fifteen (15) hours of service at club-sponsored events.

Upon renewal of membership, credit is given for each hour of service, up to fifteen, at the rate of \$10.00 per hour. (*i.e.*, a person with no service will pay \$150 more in renewal dues than a person with at least fifteen hours of service.) Service opportunities are available monthly.

### *Activities*

#### *Rifle/Pistol Range*

Members may use the 100yd Rifle and Pistol range any time except when it is reserved for a sanctioned activity. Range hours are 10:00 AM till dusk. Rifle range rules are posted at the range and found in the membership booklet and must be followed. Other scheduled activities may have additional rules.

#### *Shooting Events*

There are a number of sanctioned shooting activities held throughout the year. The exact dates and times will be announced at monthly membership meetings and may also be posted in the club house, via newsletters, e-mail, or the web site. Regularly scheduled events

#### **Bowling pin shoots**

Bowling pins are set up in a standard formation and shooters shoot them down—the fastest time wins. There are various pistol and shotgun classes.

#### **Deer Gun Sight-In**

Sight in your gun prior to deer hunting season – event open to the public, typically held 3 weekends prior to WI deer hunting season.

#### *Trap*

The club runs a three-house trap range. The range is open Tuesdays 6:00–9:00 PM (mid-May through mid-August) and Thursdays 5:00 PM-9:00 PM (league). Other days may be scheduled, depending on demand. Trap shooting is open to the public.

#### *Archery*

This archery range has fourteen stations laid out over wooded acreage that offers challenge in a natural setting. The range extends over an approximate 2/3 mile trail offering a variety of shooting distances between 15 and 40 yards at life-like animal targets.

#### *Education programs*

#### **Wisconsin DNR hunter-safety course**

Schultz's sponsors Hunter-Safety classes each year. Instructors are members of Schultz's. Classroom instruction is held at an area school and the field portion is held on club grounds. Classes are held several times a year.

#### **NRA "Sports Camps"**

Each year the club holds sports camps, based on demand: NRA/ATA Trap (spring), a family shooting camp (summer) and a Women On Target shooting camp (fall). Check the web site for dates and availability.

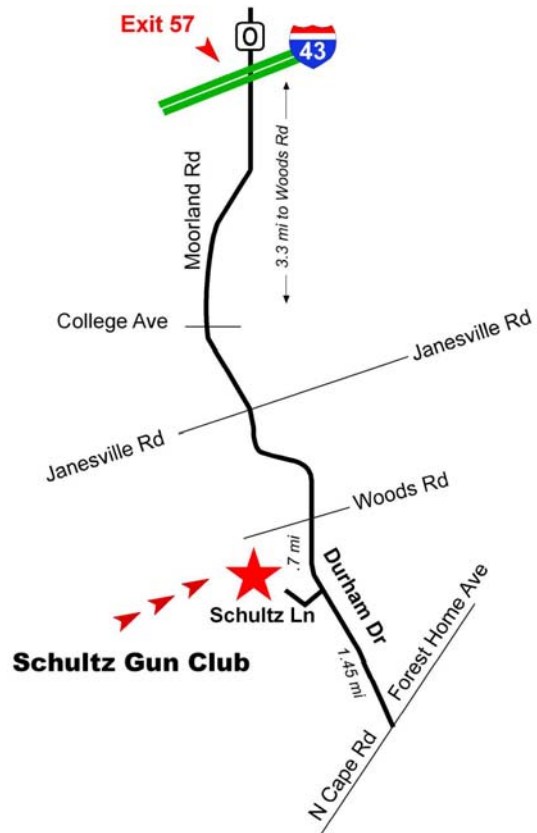
## Want to Join?
